

Vincennes AA transfer to Purdue University Fort Wayne PSY BS

Below are the list of courses student should plan to take during their AA degree to be able to complete the Psychology BS degree in 2 years after transferring to Purdue University Fort Wayne. Purdue University Fort Wayne students have to fulfill requirements in General Education (Gen Ed), the College of Arts and Sciences (A&S), and the Psychology Major. Free electives can be used for the remaining 120 credits for the BS degree. Note that some courses may fulfill requirements in both Gen Ed and either A&S or the Psychology major.
